THERE IS ONLY ONE GOOD NEWS

 I am shocked that you are turning away so soon from God, who called you to himself through the loving mercy of Christ. You are following a different way that pretends to be the Good News

- 7. which is really not another; only there are some who are disturbing you and want to distort the gospel of Christ.
- 8. But even if we, or an angel from heaven, should preach to you a gospel contrary to what we have preached to you, he is to be accursed!
- 9. As we have said before, so I say again now, if any man is preaching to you a gospel contrary to what you received, he is to be accursed!
- 10. For am I now seeking the favor of men, or of God? Or am I striving to please men? If I were still trying to please men, I would not be a bond-servant of Christ.

PAUL DEFENDS HIS MINISTRY

11. For I would have you know, brethren, that the gospel which was preached by me is not according to man.

PAUL CALLED BY GOD

CALL TO APOSTLESHIP
